## Know Your Beans?

Beans have a slight chance of cross-pollination. If you know the scientific name of your bean, then you can plant one of each species and not have to worry about crosspollination. Here are a few of the major species:

Scientific name	Common name	Examples
Phaseolus vulgaris	Common bean	Anasazi, black beans, borlotti types, pink beans, pinto, shell, white and yellow beans
Vicia faba	Fava or broad bean	Negreta, Windsor, Tarma
Phaseolus coccineus	Runner beans	Scarlet runner, sunset runner
Phaseolus Iunatus	Lima or Butter beans	Christmas, Henderson
